Garrett Mason selected to perform at Boston Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony

Halifax, November 18, 2008 - Nova Scotia is well known for many musical offerings – fiddles, bagpipes and yes, the blues! Garrett Mason has been selected by Nova Scotia *Come to life* to perform at the Boston Christmas Tree Lighting ceremony on December 4, 2008.
